



AN ATTORNEY'S GUIDE TO THE KING OF GLORY LUTHERAN CHURCH FOUNDATION

General

The King of Glory Lutheran Church Foundation was incorporated in 2008 as a Texas nonprofit corporation, and is tax-exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of The Internal Revenue Code. Its sole purpose is to support and benefit the ministries of King of Glory Lutheran Church of Dallas, Texas.

The Foundation has been designated by King of Glory as the exclusive recipient for donations made by Wills, Trust Agreements, or other methods of “planned giving” to or for the benefit of King of Glory. All assets previously held in other King of Glory accounts as memorial gifts, designated gifts, or Endowment Fund gifts have been transferred to the Foundation.

If your client desires to make a planned gift to benefit King of Glory, we ask that you identify the Foundation as the recipient in the document(s) you prepare for that purpose. Unless otherwise specified, gifts to the Foundation will be held and administered as “undesignated” funds, and the Board suggests that your client choose this option. If your client desires that the gift be for a specific purpose, the Foundation will, in general, accept gifts for such a purpose, if clearly specified.

Bequest Language

We encourage you to use your own style and language in identifying the amount or measure of the gift and the Foundation as the recipient. The correct legal name is:

Split-Interest Gifts

We encourage the naming of the Foundation as one or more of the beneficiaries of split-interest gifts, such as Charitable Remainder or Lead Trusts, Charitable Gift Annuities, and the like. At this time, the Foundation does not act as the trustee of CRTs or CLTs; however, should that service be desired, we can facilitate this through other Lutheran organizations, such as the ELCA Foundation or the Lutheran Foundation of the Southwest.
