



## AN ATTORNEY'S GUIDE TO THE KING OF GLORY LUTHERAN CHURCH FOUNDATION

### **General**

The King of Glory Lutheran Church Foundation (the Foundation) was incorporated in 2008 as a Texas nonprofit corporation, and is tax-exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of The Internal Revenue Code. Its sole purpose is to support the mission of King of Glory Lutheran Church (King of Glory) of Dallas, Texas, by supplementing ministries which might not otherwise be fully served by general operating funds.

If your client desires to make a planned gift to be managed by the Foundation, we ask that you specifically identify the Foundation *by name* as the recipient in the document(s) you prepare for that purpose. Unless otherwise specified, gifts to the Foundation will be held and administered as “undesigned” funds, and the Board suggests that your client choose this option. If your client desires that the gift be for a specific purpose, the Foundation will, in general, accept gifts for such a purpose, if clearly specified.

### **Bequest Language**

We encourage you to use your own style and language in identifying the amount or measure of the gift and the Foundation as the recipient. The correct legal name is:

### **Split-Interest Gifts**

We encourage the naming of the Foundation as one or more of the beneficiaries of split-interest gifts, such as Charitable Remainder Trusts, Charitable Gift Annuities, and the like. At this time, the Foundation does not act as the trustee of CRTs or CGAs; however, should that service be desired, we can facilitate this through other Lutheran organizations, such as the ELCA Foundation or the Lutheran Foundation of the Southwest.
